This concentration integrates coursework from the social sciences and humanities, allowing students to gain a broad and wide knowledge of the region of the Middle East and North Africa. Building on Denison's commitment to internationalizing the curriculum, this concentration engages students with a deeper understanding of the region both academically and experientially. It draws on the interdisciplinary strength of Denison's community by including courses from Anthropology and Sociology, Economics, History, International Studies, Political Science, Religion and Modern Languages. This concentration also addresses the rising demand of students for study in Arabic. Accordingly, it gives students the opportunity to integrate and contextualize their knowledge of Arabic along with a deeper understanding of the MENA region.
